

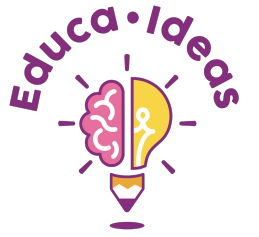

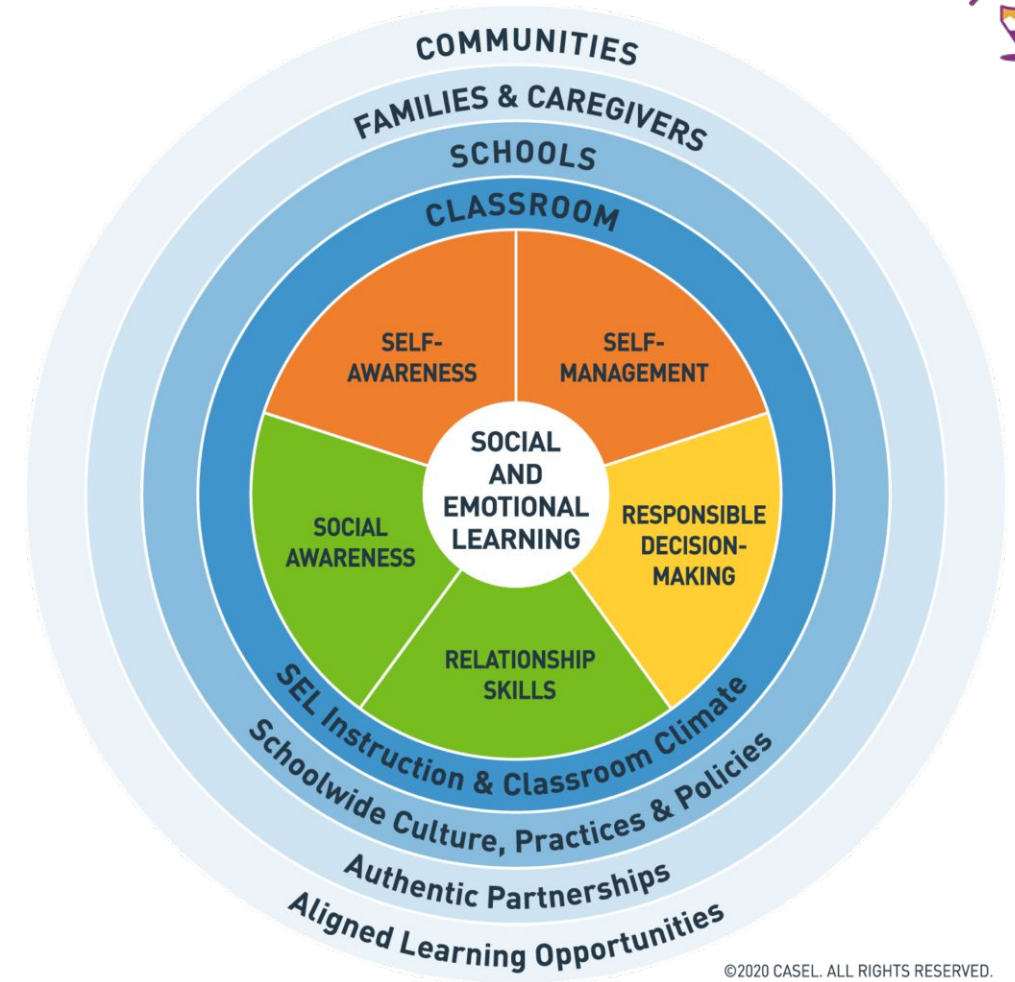

# Why including stories in your classes?

- Stories provide opportunities to learn the language
- They develop narrative thinking skills
- They foster empathy and emotional skills
- Cultivate imagination



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## How to choose a story?

- On teaching canon
- Hidden curriculum
- Relevance to your school community
- Meaningful and purposeful for your teaching context and your learners



## How to present story?

1. Audio Book (Book creator)
2. Video
3. A book/pdf
4. A podcast

## How to work with a story?

1. Let them explore their emotions through the story
2. Scaffold the story with varied and differentiated activities
3. Include interactive and dynamic activities as well as critical thinking tasks
4. Let them choose

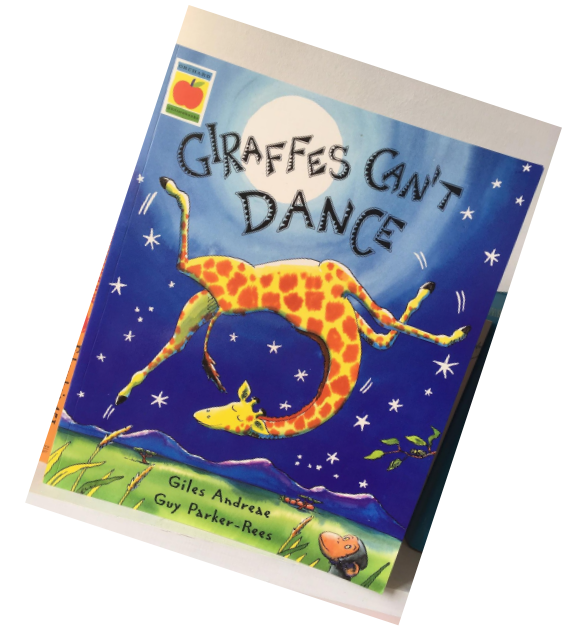
