Learn vocabulary (N=28)

After = 3.8
Up to 2 weeks after = 3.34

Paired samples t-test results indicated that for the ENACT group, there was also a statistically significant difference between the pre- (M = 0.38, SD = 0.69) and post-test scores (M = 3.80, SD = 1.67), t(27) = -11.50, p = .001 as well as the pre- (M = 3.45, SD = 1.11) and delayed post-test scores (M = 3.45, SD = 1.11), t(27) = 4.00, p = .001.

Very well made activity video, even though I don't speak a word of Spanish, it was very easy to follow it. And the outcome was beautiful!:)








