

Effective?

- Definition
- Hard to define?
- Previous studies definitions (e.g. Park & Lee, 2006), (Walls, Nardi, von Minden, & Hoffman, 2002), (e.g. Shi, 2005),
- "elusive concept" (Dincer et al., 2013).



Teacher effectiveness

- Although much work has been done to identify the characteristics of an effective teacher, there is no consensus model of the ideal teacher, his/her desirable characteristics, behaviours nor qualifications (Zamani & Ahangari, 2016).
- However, teacher effectiveness is how the teaching methods, classroom management, teacher & students expectations and classroom resources affect the students' learning (Campbell, et. al, 2012).





Mismatch between teachers' and students' views
