AgeWell International was set up in 1986. Today, it works in more than 36 low- and middle-income countries around the world. The charity responds to the needs of older people in these countries. It promotes dignity, health and social inclusion among the growing population of adults over 60.

A few facts:

- In 2050, 80% of older people will live in low- and middle-income countries.
- 80% of older adults in low- and middle-income countries have no regular income.
- Disability among people under 18 is 5.8%; it rises to 44.6% among 65–74-year-olds and 84.2% among people over 85.
- Nearly two thirds of people with dementia live in low- and middle-income countries.

How the charity helps:

- Provides specialist training and materials for healthcare professionals.
- Trains and supports carers who visit vulnerable people at home.
- Influences governments to develop healthy ageing schemes and pensions.
