Teacher's notes

COLOUR LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD

Language: Face, hair, eyes, teeth, cloak, shoes, red, green, blue, yellow, brown, pink, white

Resources: Colour Little Red Riding Hood activity sheet, crayons or felt-tip pens.

- a) Prepare a model of the activity to show your children before they start. Although Little Red Riding Hood traditionally has brown hair and a red cloak, there is no 'correct' model. For example, Little Red Riding Hood's hair may be orange and her cloak may be blue or yellow.
- b) If you are printing in black and white, first ask the children to identify and colour the words around Little Red Riding Hood.
- c) Next, show them your model. Elicit the colours of Little Red Riding Hood's body and clothes. Ask them to colour their picture in any colours they like.
- d) Now ask them to write the correct colour in each of the sentences. Monitor the children as they are colouring and writing and ask them to tell you about their pictures.
- e) Finally, ask the children to tell each other about their pictures.
