

What do they do on the farm?

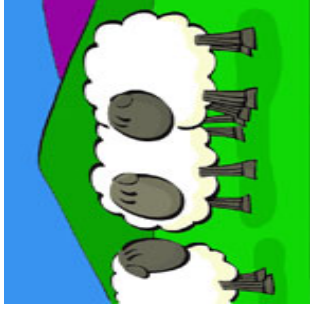
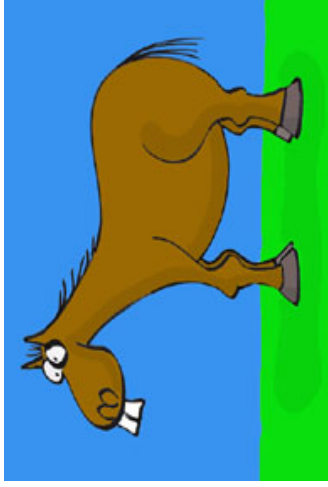
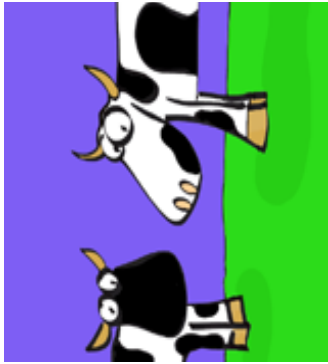
Language: chickens, cows, horses, sheep, dogs: lay, give, pull, watch; milk, the sheep, carts, eggs, wool

Resources: What do they do on the farm? activity sheet, animal and object flashcards, realia (eggs, milk, wool)

- a) Elicit the names of the animals that Old MacDonald looks after on his farm. What do the animals do on the farm? Elicit suggestions, prompting with the flashcards or realia.
- b) Place the animal flashcards on the board. Now ask for volunteers to match the object flashcards with the animals.
- c) Now read the following sentences and ask your children to tell you if each sentence is 'True' or 'False':
 - ☆ Chickens give milk
 - ☆ Cows give wool
 - ☆ Horses pull carts
 - ☆ Sheep lay eggs
 - ☆ Dogs watch sheep
- d) Now drill the correct sentences.
- e) Your children can now complete the activity sheet.
- f) As an extension activity your children might consider what ducks, cats, donkeys and other animals do on the farm.

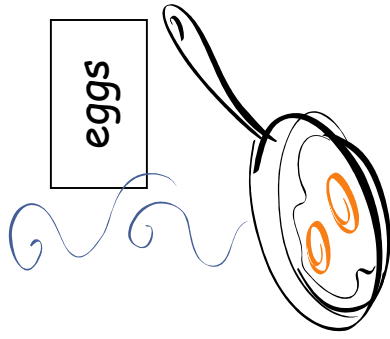

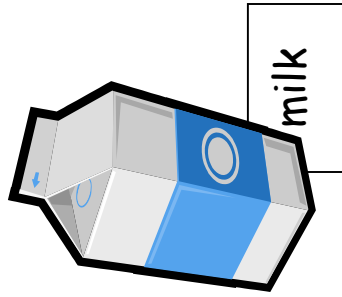

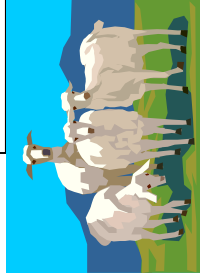
